

Instructions for Use



1. Begin with two stamped images: one on scratch cardstock paper, and the other on the final paper or surface you wish to work with.



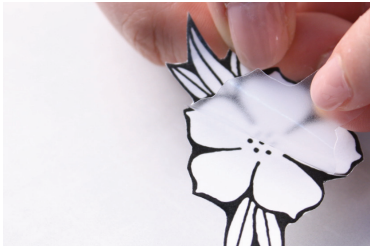
2. To get started, remove the Mask It from its backing by slowly pulling the mask from one end of the surface area.



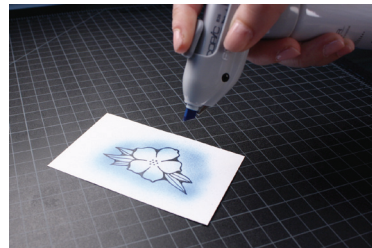
3. Carefully place the Mask It over the stamped image on the scratch cardstock. Smooth the mask out as you go, making sure there are no air bubbles or wrinkles.



4. With a sharp scissors or knife tool, cut around the outline of your stamped image.



5. Carefully peel the film from the cutout and apply to the final stamped image. Take a moment to be sure it is aligned correctly.



6. Airbrush the background area.



7. Allow ink to dry momentarily, and gently peel off the section of Mask It to reveal the finished image.



8. Tip: The Mask It film is reusable. To keep it handy, store the mask cutout on the back of the stamp.

MASK IT masking film is perfect for all your masking needs. Great for protecting areas you don't want colored when airbrushing. The clear, matte finish is easy to trace through, and works well with a light box. Medium tack adhesive makes it removable so you can reapply it to your work. It's also flexible for those hard-to-reach spots, and easy to cut into sections.
